**Introduction:** COMCEC Capital Markets Regulators Forum (CMR Forum) will be organising an online Workshop titled “Sustainability in Capital Markets” (Workshop) in collaboration with the Capital Markets Board of Türkiye (CMB Türkiye) and the Securities Commission Malaysia (SC Malaysia) on 6-7 November 2023. This is in line with the growing interest among CMR Forum member authorities following a survey which was conducted in 2022 that indicates the need for capacity building on the capital market regulatory bodies particularly in the area sustainable finance regulatory and market building guidance.

**Coverage:** The 2-day Workshop intends to cover the regulatory aspects of sustainability by focusing on Malaysia and Türkiye’s experience in pursuing the sustainability agenda in both jurisdictions. The discussion will also focus on corporate sustainability disclosure, sustainable finance instruments, institutional investor participation and other relevant areas related to sustainability within the capital market space.
