## Measures to Limit Price Volatiliy

Measure	Date of Enforcement	Current Status
Ban on short selling	<ul> <li>Initially imposed on February 28, 2020</li> <li>Extended on March 2, 2020</li> </ul>	Lifted for BIST 30 stocks on July 1, 2020
Circuit breakers tightened in Borsa Istanbul share markets	Implemented by Borsa Istanbul as of March 13, 2020	In force for downward price movements
Flexibility in margin requirements for margin trading	March 23, 2020	In force
Buy backs for Exchange traded shares without limits	Existing measure, published as reminder on March 23, 2020	In force

Measure	Date of Enforcement	Current Status
General assembly meetings postponed	Initially imposed by Presidential Decree on March 20. 2020	E-General Assembly System used for holding general assembly meetings
Working part time/splitting shifts/remote Access enabled for investment firms	March 23, 2020	In force
Receipt of client orders via alternative electronic means enabled	March 23, 2020	In force
Limitation to dividend payments by companies	With new Transitional Article of the TCC published on April 16, 2020	In force

Increased dialogue and monitoring with respect to:

- Portfolio management companies,
- Collective investment schemes
- Potential market abuse cases
